

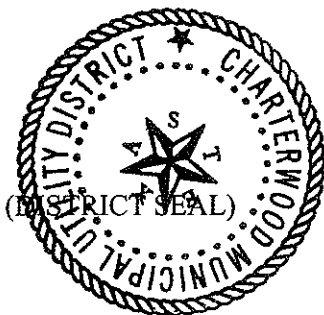
NOTICE OF MEETING


1. Approve minutes of meeting held July 27, 2010.
