
1. Conduct Public Hearing on 2018 Tax Rate.
2. Consider Adopting Order Setting Tax Rate for 2018.
3. Approve Amended Notice to Sellers and Purchasers.
4. Hear from public.
5. Receive Constable's Report and consider any action recommended by the Constable.
6. Approve minutes of meetings held August 28, 2018.
7. Receive Bookkeeper's Report, review investments, approve payment of bills and issuance of checks and consider any action recommended by the Bookkeeper.
8. Receive Tax Assessor/Collector's Report and approve issuance of tax-related checks, and consider any action recommended by the Tax Assessor/Collector, including:
  - a.) Approve resident payment plan.
9. Receive Engineer's Report, receive update on engineering and construction matters, consider approval of any change orders or pay requests and consider any action recommended by the Engineer, including:
  - a.) Authorize Engineer to bid District projects; and
  - b.) Review status of Windwood Presbyterian Church service application.
10. Receiver Operator's Report, including approval of termination list, review of customer correspondence and consider any action recommended by the Operator.
11. Receive and act on Michael Murr's report and consider any action recommended.
12. Receive Attorney's Report and consider any action recommended by the Attorney; including:
  - a.) Approve Resolution in Support of Legislation Increasing Tax Rate for Recreational Facilities to Three Percent of Taxable Value; and
  - b.) Hear update on Commercial Parking Petition and consider any action recommended.
13. Consider entering into service agreement with Joshua Cox, CCIM.
14. Receive comments from directors and authorize appropriate action.
15. Review District emails and consider acting thereon.
