
1. Hear from public.
2. Receive Constable's Report and consider any action recommended by the Constables.
3. Approve minutes of meetings held March 26, 2019.
4. Receive Bookkeeper's Report, review investments, approve payment of bills and issuance of checks and consider any action recommended by the Bookkeeper.
5. Receive Tax Assessor/Collector's Report and approve issuance of tax-related checks, and consider any action recommended by the Tax Assessor/Collector.
6. Receive Engineer's Report, receive update on engineering and construction matters, consider approval of any change orders or pay requests and consider any action recommended by the Engineer, including:
  - a.) Authorize Engineer to bid District projects; and
  - b.) Update status of District's five-year maintenance plan, including prioritizing outfall repairs.
7. Receiver Operator's Report, including approval of termination list, review of customer correspondence and consider any action recommended by the Operator.
8. Receive and act on Michael Murr's report and consider any action recommended, including:
  - a.) Hear update on security cameras; and
  - b.) Review and consider action on Dog Park Plan, including cost estimates.
9. Receive Attorney's Report and consider any action recommended by the Attorney, including:
  - a.) Update on local bill regarding recreational facilities;
  - b.) Approve Resolution Declaring Intent to Reimburse Expenses with Surplus Funds; and
  - c.) Approve template for mailouts to residents in Charterwood Section 1 regarding Charterwood Drive Parking Petition.
10. Receive comments from directors and authorize appropriate action.
11. Review District emails and consider acting thereon.

Pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code, Chapter 551, as amended, the Board of Directors may convene in closed session to receive advice from legal counsel and discuss matters relating to pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters and/or real estate transactions, gifts and donations, security devices and/or economic development negotiations.
